Skill Set: Individuals who possess a deep appreciation for animal welfare, nonprofit mission, and community engagement are encouraged to apply. We are looking for team members who can be strong ambassadors of GMP's mission, and are able to leverage their strengths to drive sustainable growth for a fledgling nonprofit.

Key Responsibilities: Support monthly board meetings, actively support and participate on a GMP committee, help with brainstorming and decision making for the benefit of the organization, and ensure GMP stays mission-driven and compliant. Board members will be ambassadors of GMP and develop relationships across the Olympic Peninsula with a variety of stakeholders, partners, and community members. These responsibilities will adapt with growth and maturity of the organization; flexibility and foresight for the organization will be required.

Commitment: Board positions are one year commitments with no term limits. Board members will be encouraged to have open dialogue with Founder + Program Veterinarian to ensure mutually beneficial relationships and opportunities to grow within the organization in other capacities.
